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REPORT OF MAIN HOSTEL -2023-2024

The main hostel of the college has been functioning with great distinction since 1976. The College Principal, Dr. A. John Peter, is effectively served as the Hostel Warden. The Deputy Warden of the undergraduate (UG) hostel, Dr. A. Mehkarunisa Begum, Assistant Professor of Economics, and the Deputy Warden of the postgraduate (PG) Hostel, Dr. P. Thangamathi, Associate Professor of Zoology, are also carrying out their duties efficiently. A total of 283 undergraduate (UG) students and 65 postgraduate (PG) students are currently residing in the hostel and benefiting from its facilities.

- On 04.10.2023, an awareness programme on 'Women's Safety and Self-Confidence' was conducted by Police Officers Kalaivani, Krishnaveni, Selvarani, and Revathi.
- Yoga training classes were organized by the *Vazhga Valamudun Arivu Thirukovil* organization for three days on 28.10.2023, 29.10.2023, and 15.12.2023.
- Students are receiving excellent training for competitive examinations such as TNPSC, Group II, Group IV, as well as for Hindi, Tailoring, and Beautician classes.
- A blood testing camp for the prevention of elephantiasis was held on 05.01.2024.
- A vegetable garden was established in front of the senior hostel on 22.01.2024, and a security fence was installed around it.
- On 12.02.2024 and 13.02.2024, pits for preparing vermicompost using vegetable waste and for recycling hostel garbage were created.

REPORT OF MAIN HOSTEL -2024-2025

The main hostel has been functioning on the college campus since 1976. The Principal serves as the hostel warden, while Dr. K. Hemalatha, Assistant Professor of Geography, is the UG hostel deputy warden, and Dr. P. Thangamathi, Associate Professor of Zoology, is the PG hostel deputy warden.

- On 21.06.2024, the hostel students visited the Southern Cultural Center to receive yoga training in observance of International Yoga Day. They were also instructed by the 'Sky Yoga' Forum to provide yoga training to fellow hostel students within the hostel campus.
- The students attended the Thanjavur Book Fair held at the Palace premises on 20.07.2024 and 21.07.2024.
- An awareness program on women's safety and self-confidence was conducted by police officers on 04.10.2024.
- 17.12.2024 and 18.12.2024, meditation training was provided to the students by Ms. R. Radhika, founder of the Heartfulness Institute.
- A mushroom cultivation workshop was conducted on 25.02.2025, with training provided by Mr. R. Senthilkumar.
- In celebration of Women's Day, Ms. R. Radhika, founder of the Heartfulness Institute, organized sports competitions for the hostel students. Prizes were awarded to the winners, and meditation training was also provided. This year, the hostel was named 'Neithal Illam'.
